In the middle of the Sahara a fort is discovered where everyone is dead. There has been no invasion. The commanding officer is dead, murdered by a soldier from his own ranks who has since disappeared. We will look at the journals and letters that were and might have been written by the characters and discover the solution to the mystery.
